About Tuskegee . . .

Tuskegee is home to some 11,000 people and is the county seat of Macon County. This city is recognized for being an important site in various stages of African American history.

In 1881, Booker T. Washington founded the Tuskegee Normal School for Colored Teachers on a former plantation. It was later named the Tuskegee Institute and then Tuskegee University, with the mission of educating freedmen for self-sufficiency. The university is a center of excellence for African-American education. The heart of the university has been designated a National Historic District. One of the most famous teachers at Tuskegee was George Washington Carver. He is well-known for his innovative research into Southern farming methods and products developed from a variety of crops. Tuskegee and Tuskegee Institute were also home to the famed Tuskegee Airmen, the first squadron of African-American pilots trained in the U.S. Military. The town is also the birthplace of Rosa Parks who went on to spark the civil rights movement in the 1950's.

Tuskegee with its great history and culture is the homestead of the WHEW Family. We hope you will take the time to learn more about this historical city.
